


### Quick Start Guide

To enjoy Airplay and internet radio, you must first connect your Air to your home network.

For wired set-up instructions, see the online user's manual.

Plug in the Air to the mains power and press the power button on top of the unit. Wait for up to 20 seconds for the flashing light on the rear panel to flash green and orange



### Apple Wireless Accessory Configuration

If you have an Apple mobile device, go to the 'Settings -> Wi-Fi' menu. Choose the Air showing under 'Set up New Airplay Speaker' and follow the instructions.

Otherwise, proceed to section 2-6.

Go to your computer and click on the WiFi/network logo and select Air 100/200.



- Open a new page in your internet browser (Internet Explorer, Safari, Chrome etc). In the address bar of your browser, type 192.168.1.1 followed by 'enter' and the Air setup page will be displayed.
- Select your home Wi-Fi network from the 'Select Network' drop-down list of choices.



Type your home Wi-Fi/Network password into the red box, and click the 'Save' button.

(Don't know your Wi-Fi password key? It's commonly found on a label on your internet modem/router).



After a few seconds, the Air will be connected to your network (successful connection is indicated by a solid green light on the rear of the product). This can take up to 30 seconds.

(If your computer/tablet has not already done so automatically, change the Wi-Fi/network setting on your computer/tablet back to your home network).

### Internet Radio

Once you have connected your Air to your home network then you're ready to listen to internet radio!

To get you started, we've stored 10 of our favourite internet radio stations in your presets. Presets 1-5 can be easily selected and played by pressing buttons 1-5 on the top of the unit.

Presets 1-10 can be selected using the remote control or the free Air App.

Also, using the Air App, you can search for new stations from around the world and change the presets to your own preferred stations.

### Bluetooth

Press the \$\infty\$ button on the Air to put your Air into Bluetooth pairing

Enable Bluetooth connectivity on your Bluetooth device (eg. phone, tablet, etc) and pair with the Air (you may need to consult your phone or tablet operating instructions).


Once paired, music from your device will play through the Air.

### Made a mistake?

To reset the Air, press and hold the power button and WPS button on the rear panel for 10 - 15 seconds until the Air switches off. Then start again at Step 1. You can also watch the Air connection videos on the Cambridge Audio website for further explanation.





# Spotify

Spotify lets you listen to millions of songs – the artists you love, the latest hits and discoveries just for you. If you are a Spotify Premium user, you can control your Air using the Spotify app.

- 1. Connect your Air to the same Wi-Fi network as your phone or tablet running the Spotify app.
- 2. Open the Spotify app, and play any song.
- 3. Tap the song image in the bottom left of the screen.
- 4. Tap the Connect icon .
- 5. Pick your Air from the list.

## Airplay


When you open iTunes or your Music you will see the Airplay logo allowing you to select your Air as the playback device.

Note – When Air is selected, it may take a few seconds to connect. Wait for the music to start playing before adjusting the volume.

### AUX button

Pressing AUX once will stop the playback of Airplay, Bluetooth or Internet radio and select the MP3 input.

Pressing AUX a second time will toggle between AUX inputs.





The Air will automatically turn off after eight hours use. This environmental feature can be adjusted or disabled in the Air App, available from the iTunes App store or Google Play store.
